- From a family of grapes not only used for winemaking, but table grapes and raisins
- One of the oldest known to man
- This is a clone of the varietal that references little berries in its name
- This particular varietal is regarded as the best of this particular family
- Often perfumy and musky with ripe-grape characteristics

Tasting Notes:

450 Cases Produced

A beautiful Italian clone of the famous Muscat Blanc a Petits Grains, this live fresh wine abounds with floral notes, apricot, peach and exotic fruits. The impression is that you are about to taste a sweet wine, but you are in for a surprise. What is delivered is a crisp, dry and elegant wine that is hard to match. This is NOT the sweet sparkling Moscato d'Asti, but a remarkable classic white.

Answer – Azienda Agricola de TARCZAL Marano d'isera – Italia
2005 Trentino -- Moscato Giallo (this is the grape)
