White Bag Clues: **Serve in a Flute**

Grape -

- Is it white? Is it red? No, It's ROSÉ!
- Smooth and rounded flavor with a lively burst of red fruits on the palate.
- Bottlings of this grape are rarely seen in the US.
- Generally used to make Rosé
- An ancient black grape native to the region.

Where is it from?

- Henry the 8th first wife hailed from the kingdom that formerly housed this region.
- On December 22nd 1979, this region was officially recognized as a nationality
- The official language in this region is Spanish, but another is the national.

Producer –

- This producer has been in the family for seven centuries.
- First started making this style of wine in 1936.
- Still aged in the original cellars that are ten meters underground and maintain a constant temperature of 14 degrees Celsius all year.

Answer – D.O. Catalunya Cava Rosado – Trepato 100%

Bohigas Cava Rosado Trepato 100% A beautiful sparkling wine for celebrating with friends, Cava Rosado is a delicious deep pink color with fresh strawberries on the nose, it has plenty of fruit flavors but is dry, crisp and refreshing. The Bohigas winery is situated in the picturesque Anoia river valley east of Barcelona on “Can Masia”, one of the oldest country estates in Catalunya. Run by Jordi Casanovas, it has been in the family for seven centuries. The family first started making cava in 1936, and they are still aged in the original cellars that are ten meters underground and maintain a constant temperature of 14 degrees Celsius all year.
