Jared Boyle, owner of Alexandria Nicole Cellars has produced an outstanding 2003 Syrah. This wine passionately expresses the terroir of the Destiny Ridge Vineyard. Aged 18 months in both French and American Oak, this estate Syrah has an expressive bouquet of raspberries and dark fruit that is complemented with its bold perfume spice, hints of wet stone minerals, violets, earthy leather, smoked meats, vanilla and refreshing mocha.

Red Mountain ~ Kiona

Kiona Winery is one of the pioneers of Washington's Red Mountain AVA. This full bodied, fruit loaded Syrah is produced from Kiona's vineyards. The grapes were harvested at their prime and fermented in small lots. The final blend sports mineral, currant and fruit aromas accompanied by light spice and pepper with a rich smooth finish.

Yakima Valley ~ Chateau Faire le Pont

The winery name is a French term that means: "Bridging the Gap" It's used when a holiday falls mid-week and you are having such a great time that you decide to go ahead and extend it through the weekend. This is the philosophy of this great Washington winery. You'll find their Syrah to be dark, dense and full-bodied. Created in the French style, this Syrah is fruit forward, peppery and lush. Nicely balanced with firm tannins and acidity, the intense plum, blackberry and black cherry flavors linger through the long polished finish.
